1. **DATE** – Saturday, December 11, 2010 **APPLICATION DEADLINE:** November 27th, 2010
2. **THEME** – *“Making Spirits Bright”*
3. **TIME** - First unit steps off at 10 a.m. **SHARP.** Units not in position will be placed in the last division.
4. **HOW TO ENTER** – Fill in and return the entry blank, enclosed with this sheet to the Woodland Chamber of Commerce at 307 First St., Woodland, CA 95695. If you need additional information, phone (530) 662-7327. Please give **DETAILED** information on each entry submitted; if possible, enclose an 8 x 10 black and white, or color photo. *Please note that entry in this parade is by invitation only and the Parade Committee at its discretion reserves the right to refuse any entry.*
5. **Enclose appropriate entry fee** – *NO REFUNDS IN THE EVENT THE PARADE IS CANCELED. (Check should be payable to the Woodland Chamber)
6. **AWARDS** – Will be presented – time approximate – 2:30 p.m.
7. **LOCATION** – Steps of the County Court House –725 Court St.
8. **FORMATION AREA** – Units, except horses, will be staggered per paragraph 4 of application. All entrants will receive a map of the formation area and information as to the time of arrival and routes into the area. Unit of divisions and numbers will also be given to you as part of your packet. This information will be mailed to you directly after November 27th application deadline. Horse units will be staged on both sides of California Street, south of Main St. towards Lincoln Ave.
9. **COMPETITION AREA** – A SILENT ZONE (for bands, drill team/marching units) will be marked 100 feet before the start of the judging area; silence must be maintained in this zone. The judging area will be 450 feet long and the width of the city street.
 - **Be sure to review Parade Rules for route requirements and time limits within the competition area.**

Remember this is a continuous moving Parade and there is no stopping to perform at the judging/ revenue stand

 - The start and finish competition lines and the silent zone will be marked with signs.
 - The judge’s stand will be to the right of the units.
10. **REVIEW STAND** – Will be located on the right side (south) of the street. The review stand will be located in front of the Opera House and will occur here. Two stands are at this site; the first contains the judges for all categories and the second contains VIPS/Dignitaries.

RELEASE, WAIVER AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of permitting ("Participant" *i.e.*, *Companies, Organizations, Individuals*) to participate in the Woodland Holiday Parade in the City of Woodland, County of Yolo, and the State of California, on December 11, 2010, the undersigned agrees to release, indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Woodland Chamber of Commerce and City of Woodland ("Sponsors") and their officers, officials, agents, employees and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability, costs and damages (whether in contract, tort or strict liability, including but not limited to personal injury, death at any time and property damage) incurred by Sponsors, Participant or any other person, and from any and all claims, demands and actions in law or equity (including attorney's fees and legal expenses), arising or alleged to have arisen out of Participant's participation in the Holiday Parade. IT IS THE INTENTION OF PARTICIPANT BY THIS DOCUMENT, TO HAVE AGREED TO THE ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK FOR PARTICIPANT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HOLIDAY PARADE AND PARTICIPANT DOES HEREBY VOLUNTARILY RELEASE THE SPONSORS AND THEIR OFFICERS, OFFICIALS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS AND VOLUNTEERS FROM, AND DOES WAIVE ANY RIGHT OF ACTION OR CLAIM FOR, ANY LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR WRONGFUL DEATH CAUSED BY ANY OF THEIR NEGLIGENCE.

The Undersigned, for company/organization, him/herself, his/her heirs, executors, administrators or assigns agrees and understands that participation in the Holiday Parade for which this Release, Waiver and Indemnity Agreement is requested, does not make company/organization, him/herself an employee of the Chamber or City and does not grant them any right, title or interest in any Workers' Compensation benefits offered employees of the Chamber or City. Further the Undersigned, for the company/organization, him/herself, his/her heirs, executors, administrators or assigns waives and relinquishes any interest or right to claim any interest in employment benefits offered employees of the Sponsors by reason of any common law employee rights theory or similar employment entitlements of any kind.

Sponsors shall be reimbursed for all costs (including attorney's fees and legal expenses) incurred by Chamber or City in enforcing this Agreement.

This Release, Waiver and Indemnity Agreement shall survive Participant's participation in the Holiday Parade.

The undersigned agrees that the contents of this document shall be binding upon the company's, organizations assigns, his/her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

The undersigned acknowledges that he/she (i) has read and fully understands the content of this Release, Waiver and Indemnity Agreement; (ii) is aware that this is a release of liability and a contract between the Sponsors and Participant; (iii) has been fully and completely advised of the potential dangers incidental to participating in the Holiday Parade; (iv) has had the opportunity to consult with his/her attorney, in his/her discretion; and (v) is fully aware of the legal consequences of signing this document.
