Frequently asked questions!

What is the date for the 2010 Parade?

Parade will be held on Saturday December 11, 2010.

What is the 2010 parade Theme?

“Making Spirits Bright”

How do I enter the parade?

Parade entries are available at the Chamber, 307 First Street in Woodland and on the Chamber’s website at [Woodland Chamber of Commerce - Chamber Events](#). The website section provides links to general parade information, applications, category lists, rules, and parade maps. The fees to enter are:

- \$15 Not-for-Profits, Bands, ROTC units, Horses
- \$25 Commercial Entries
- \$50 Political Entries

The deadline to submit parade applications for 2010 is November 27th.

How much time does the parade take?

The parade begins at 10am and usually ends at approximately around 1pm depending upon the number of entries.

If I want to set up a food or craft booth during the parade, how do I do that?

Vendors MUST REGISTER with the City of Woodland Community Development Department, 300 First Street, Woodland and secure a Temporary Outdoor Use Permit.

Non-profits should show proof of status so the \$68 fee can be waived. Food vendors are also required to contact the Yolo County Health Department and obtain a permit. They are located at 10 North Cottonwood Street or you can reach them by phone at (530) 666-8645.

What happens to the parade if it rains?

The parade will go rain or shine. Check the Chamber’s website for updated information on the parade at www.woodlandchamber.org or call at (530) 662-7327.

How are the parade entries judged?

Entries are judged by categories: bands, floats, horses, novelties, and military/ROTC. Each category has its own set of judges. We use a total of 12 judges including California band accredited judges and CSHA horse judges. Please click here to review the [category List](#).
